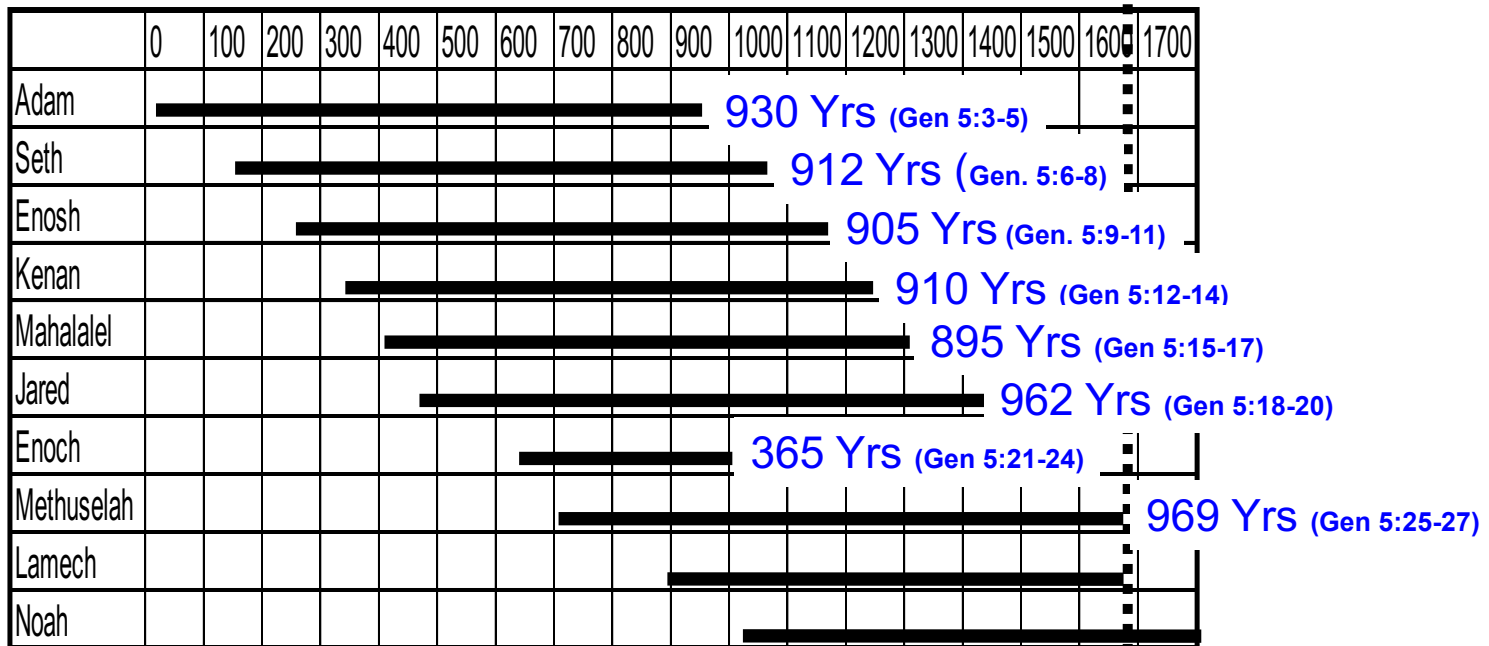

Distinctions between the Rapture & the Second Advent

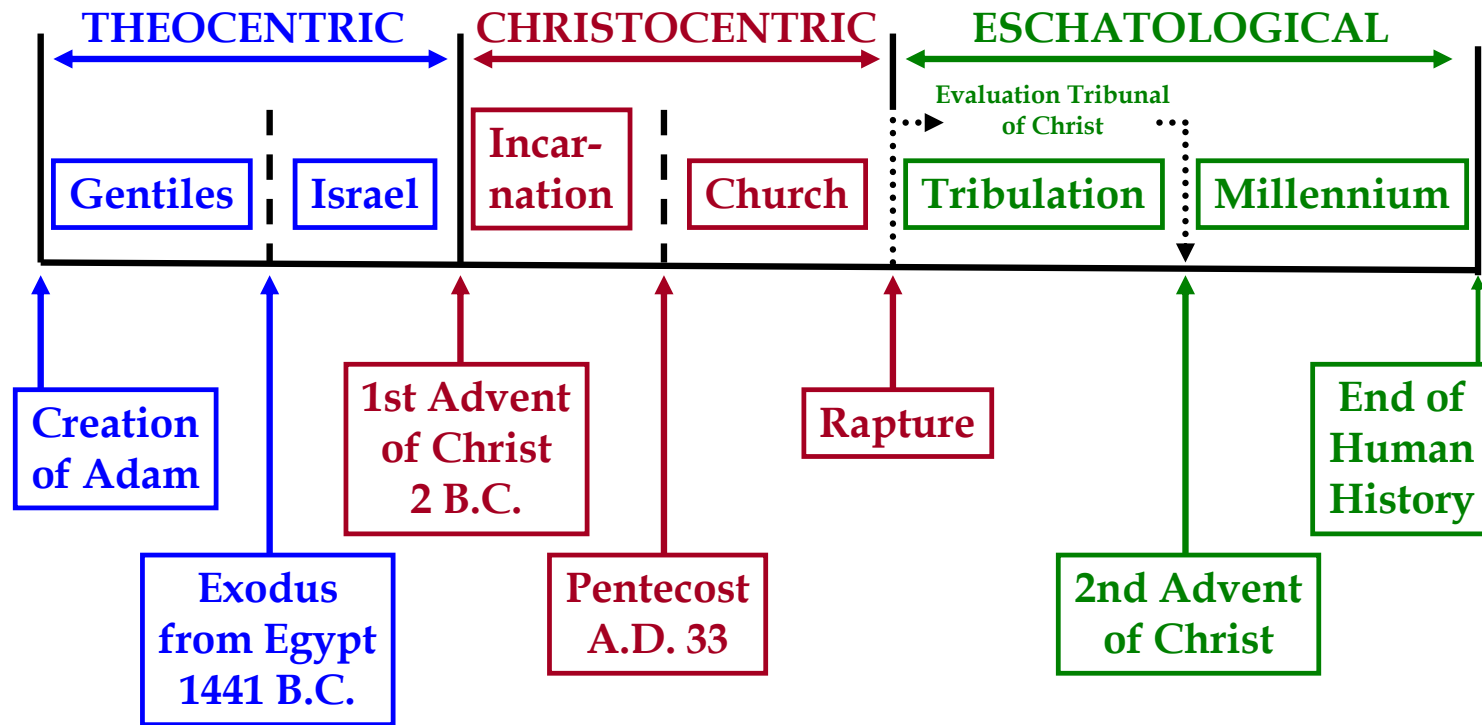
RAPTURE

SECOND ADVENT

1. Private (Acts 1:11)	Public (Rev. 19:11-16)
2. In the air (1 Thess. 4:17)	On earth (Zech. 14:4)
3. Judgment of believers' works. (2 Cor. 5:10)	Baptisms of Fire (Matt. 25:31-46)
4. Church goes to heaven (John 14:3)	Church returns with Christ (1 Thess. 3:13)
5. Holy Spirit is removed (2 Thess. 2:6-7)	Satan is removed (Rev. 20:1-3)
6. Change in believer's body (Phil. 3:21)	Earth is changed (Zech 14:9; Rom. 8:19-22)
7. Christ appears as the Groom	He appears as the Messiah
8. End of the Church Age	End of the Jewish Age
9. Israel under the fifth cycle of discipline	Termination of the fifth cycle of discipline
10. Believers taken from the earth (1 Thess. 4:16-17)	Unbelievers taken from the earth (Matt. 24:37-43)

DISPENSATIONS



The Evaluation Tribunal of Christ: Judgment of Works by Fire

WOOD represents human good: works performed in carnality, such as establishment truth and basic morality, but not rewardable.

HAY illustrates dead works: arrogant efforts to please God while in status quo carnality.

STRAW speaks of the production of evil: cosmic panaceas which attempt to solve the problems of life apart from the grace of God, doctrine, & divine establishment.

Refining of **GOLD** exemplifies great purity or a test of steadfastness.

SILVER is the metal that signifies redemption through faith in Christ.

PRECIOUS STONES symbolize the production of the fruit of the Holy Spirit.

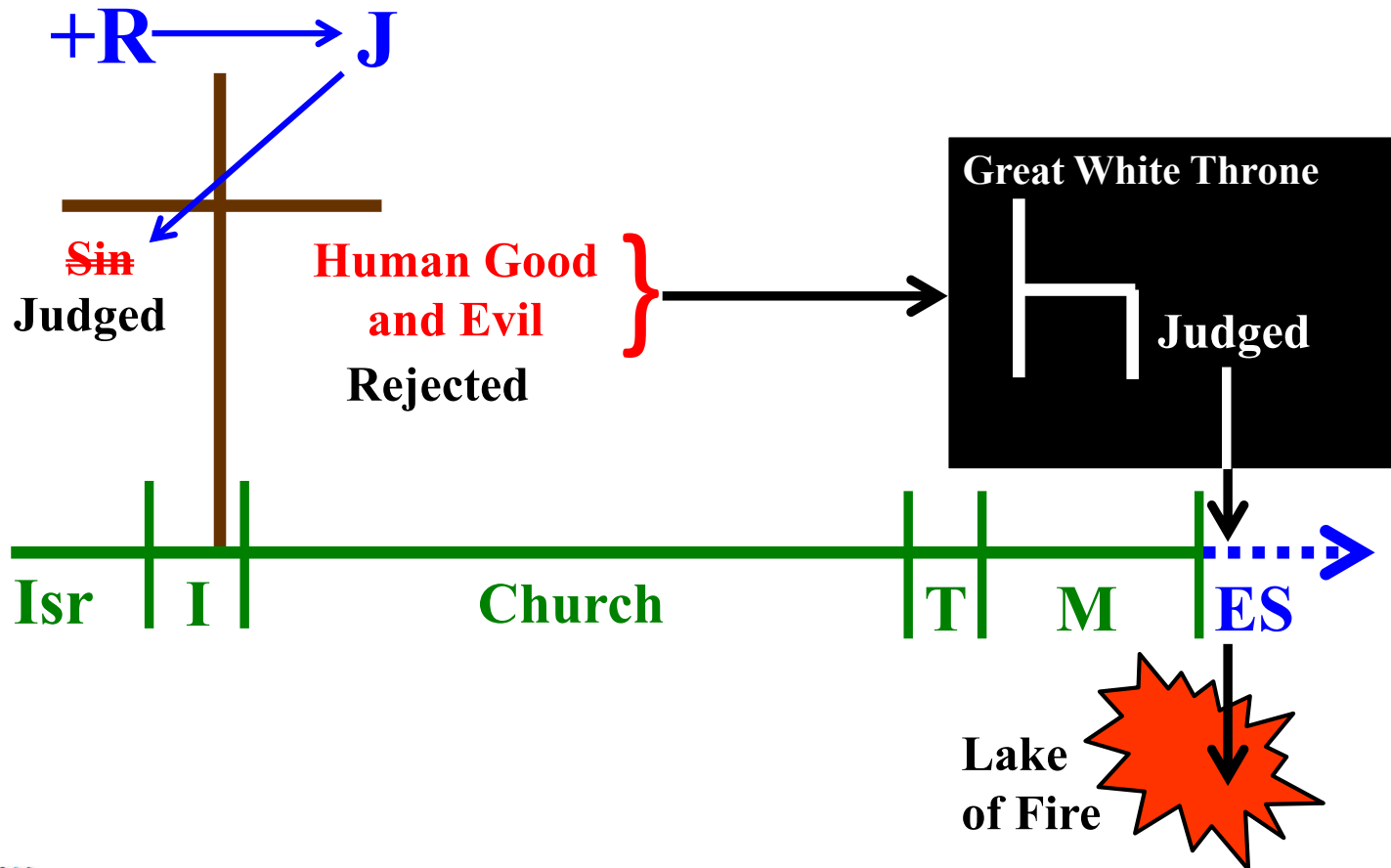

The Evaluation Tribunal of Christ

Second Nike: The Crown of Life (Rev. 2:10)

Third Nike: New name of aristocracy (Rev. 2:17)

Fourth Nike (par. 2): Investiture into the Most Noble Order of the Morning Star (Rev. 2:28)

Fifth Nike (par. 1-3): The Uniform of Glory, new title written in the Book of Life, & presentation at court before the Father (Rev. 3:5)

Sixth Nike (par. 1 & 2): Achievements engraved on a stela in the temple & a grant of a coat of arms (Rev. 3:12)
